Meeting of Electors.

- (a) The electors shall convene at the State Capitol at 2 p.m. on the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December following their election and shall perform their duties as prescribed by federal law.
- (b) The secretary of state shall arrange for the meeting place, notify the electors, and <u>call</u> the meeting to order. The secretary shall act as temporary chair of the meeting <u>until</u> the electors elect a chair from among themselves.
- (c) If an elector is absent at the time for convening the meeting, the <u>electors may declare</u> the elector position vacant by a majority vote of those present at the meeting.
