## **Art. 14.01. Offence Within View.**

**(a) A peace officer  
or any other person,  
may, without a warrant,  
arrest an offender**

**when the offense is committed in his presence or within his view,  
if the offense is one classed as a felony  
or as an offense against the public peace.**

**(b) A peace officer may arrest an offender without a warrant  
for any offense  
committed in his presence or within his view.**
